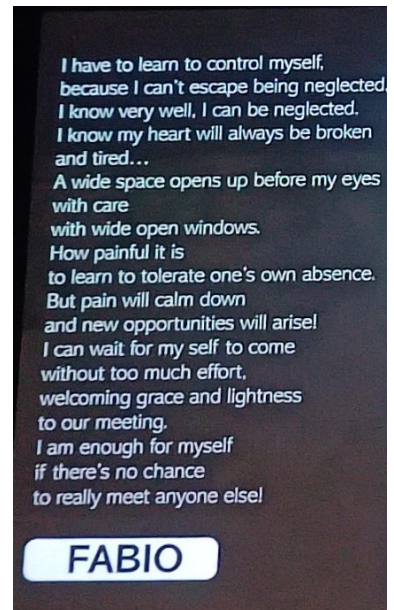
### ACT-IT-OUT PILOT WORKSHOPS
